Dredging Operations in the Backwater Channel, Holes Bay

In connection with the Poole Harbour Second Crossing construction works, dredging operations will take place in the Backwater Channel in Holes Bay.

See chartlet for area affected.

The dredging will be carried out by the Poole Harbour Commissioners grab dredger "C.H. Horn" and the hopper barge Nab between the hours of approximately 08:00 and 22:00 up to seven days a week, as required.

The dredger will show the lights and shapes appropriate to indicate a vessel engaged in dredging operations and mariners are requested to pass with caution and at slow speed.

The dredger will maintain a listening watch on Poole Harbour's working channel VHF channel 14, call sign "C. H. Horn".

Operations are expected to start on or about the 1st of August and will continue for approximately five weeks.
