TWIN SAILS BRIDGE

Mariners are reminded that during the build program of the Twin Sails Bridge, the only water safe for navigation is between the central main piers (central lifting span).

The water on either side remains part of the construction site and work taking place may result in the accidental dropping of tools, nuts, bolts etc. The openings may also contain scaffolding which may be partly or wholly submerged and a danger to navigation.


For health and safety reasons and in the interests of good seamanship, the water either side of the central main piers remain closed to navigation, and notices to this effect will be displayed.
