Turbidity Monitoring Buoy

In connection with the on-going monitoring of levels of suspended silt in Poole Harbour waters resulting from dredging operations, a yellow buoy has been placed as shown on the accompanying plan in the following position :

Latitude 50° 42'.082 N

Longitude 01° 57'.766 W

This position is on the port side of the Middle Ship Channel, East South East of buoy no. 24.

The buoy will remain in this position for about one month from this date.

Mariners are reminded that Radar, telephone and VHF Channels are recorded.
