



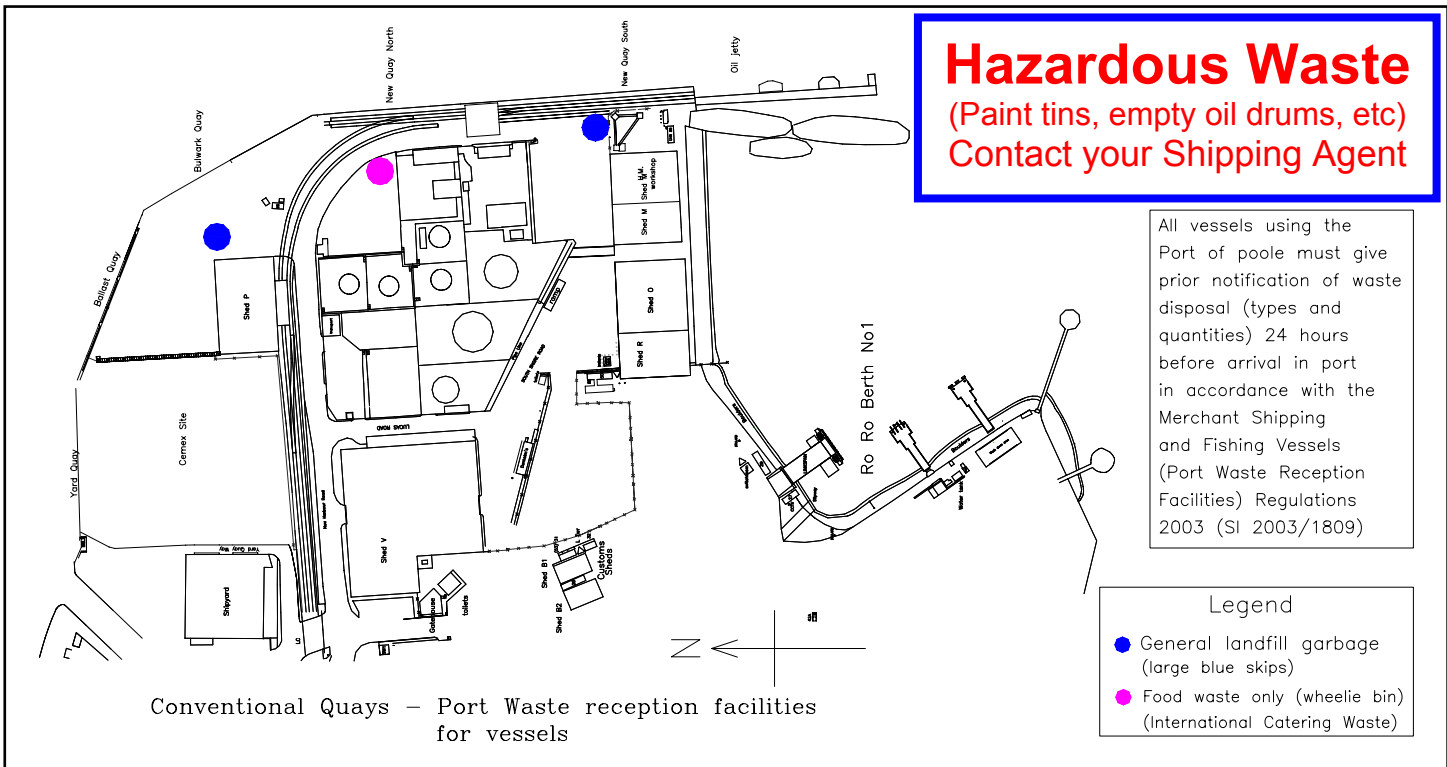

Requirements for all other Waste Streams

Your Ship's Agent will make the necessary arrangements with approved contractors to meet the requirements for all other waste streams that you may wish to land.

At the request of the Ship's Agent, the Port Environmental Adviser can make arrangements on his behalf with a waste contractor/PHC. Charges in addition to the environment charge would apply.

Hazardous Waste

Must NOT be placed in the general landfill waste facilities. Hazardous waste includes;

- Tyres
- Electrical equipment (televisions, monitors, telephones, etc.)
- Fluorescent lamps
- Paints tins & Paints (even if empty and/or where contents are dry)
- Dry cell batteries (small AA, mobile phone, etc.)
- Lead acid batteries
- Drums that contain oil or oily residues
- Oil contaminated material
- Aerosols
- Solvents
- Asbestos
- Acids
- Oil
- Bilge Water
- Liquids of any kind

And any other hazardous material

Cost of disposal of hazardous waste is charged in addition to the Environment Charge.

Cargo Residues and Hold Cleanings

Speak to your Ships Agent to make the necessary arrangements for skips, etc. Notification for the arrangement for skips should be made on the waste pre-notification declaration form to the port.

Washings from the hold must be pumped into the vessel's bilges for discharge ashore into road tankers (by arrangement your Ship's Agent) or into the vessels holding tanks. Washings are not to be pumped into the harbour.

Cost of disposal of cargo residues and hold cleanings are charged in addition to the Environment Charge.

Sewage

Arrangements must be made through your Ships Agent for disposal by an approved waste contractor.

Cost of arrangement and disposal of sewage will be charged in addition to the 'Environment Charge'.

For all other waste items not listed (e.g. pyrotechnics, clinical waste, etc.)

Arrangements must be made through your Ship's Agent for appropriate disposal by an approved waste contractor.

Cost of arrangement and disposal of these waste streams will be charged in addition to the Environment Charge.

RoRo Cargo Vessels

If your vessel is using a RoRo berth and has notified that you intend to land waste; arrangements will be made by the Port Managers Office for appropriate general waste reception facilities to be made available at the berth. For specific requirements the arrangements should be made through your Ship's Agent in the first instance.

It is the Port of Poole's policy for the Ship's Agent to make the necessary arrangements with approved contractors to meet the ships requirements for all waste streams that the ship may wish to land other than general garbage and international catering waste. At the request of the Ship's Agent, the Port Environmental Adviser can make arrangements on his behalf with waste contractor/PHC. Charges in addition to the mandatory environment charge would apply.
