## Dredging Operations MDL Cobbs Quay Marina

Mariners are advised that dredging operations at Cobbs Quay Marina in Holes Bay will commence on or about the 22nd October 2018 for approximately five weeks.

The work will be carried out by the backhoe dredger "Witton II", with the spoil being disposed of at the 'in harbour' spoil ground East of Brownsea Island, or the spoil ground off Swanage, by the self-propelled hopper barges "Split Two and/or Split Three".

All vessels will be exhibiting the required lights and/or shapes as per the COLREGS.

Mariners are advised to navigate with extreme caution when the Split Barges are transiting Holes Bay, between the bridges and Little Channel, and are requested to keep clear of the "Witton II".

Dates and timings are weather dependent.

For further information please contact Poole Harbour Control on VHF channel 14.

This notice will self cancel on completion of the dredging operation.

**Mariners are reminded that Radar, telephone and VHF Channels are recorded.**
