



Harbour Master permission required by Permit application.



Pay online phc.co.uk/shop/ or at the Harbour Office.



Please note the vessel must also be in possession of valid Harbour Dues.



Minimum 3rd party insurance required.



Minimum of 2 people on the boat whilst towing a skier (one driving, one observer).



The Vessel must have a name or number that is clearly identifiable.



Ski boats must navigate the designated area in an anticlockwise direction.



Persons riding on towed inflatables are not permitted anywhere within Poole Harbour Limits.



No Water skiing/Wakeboarding Sunset till Sunrise.

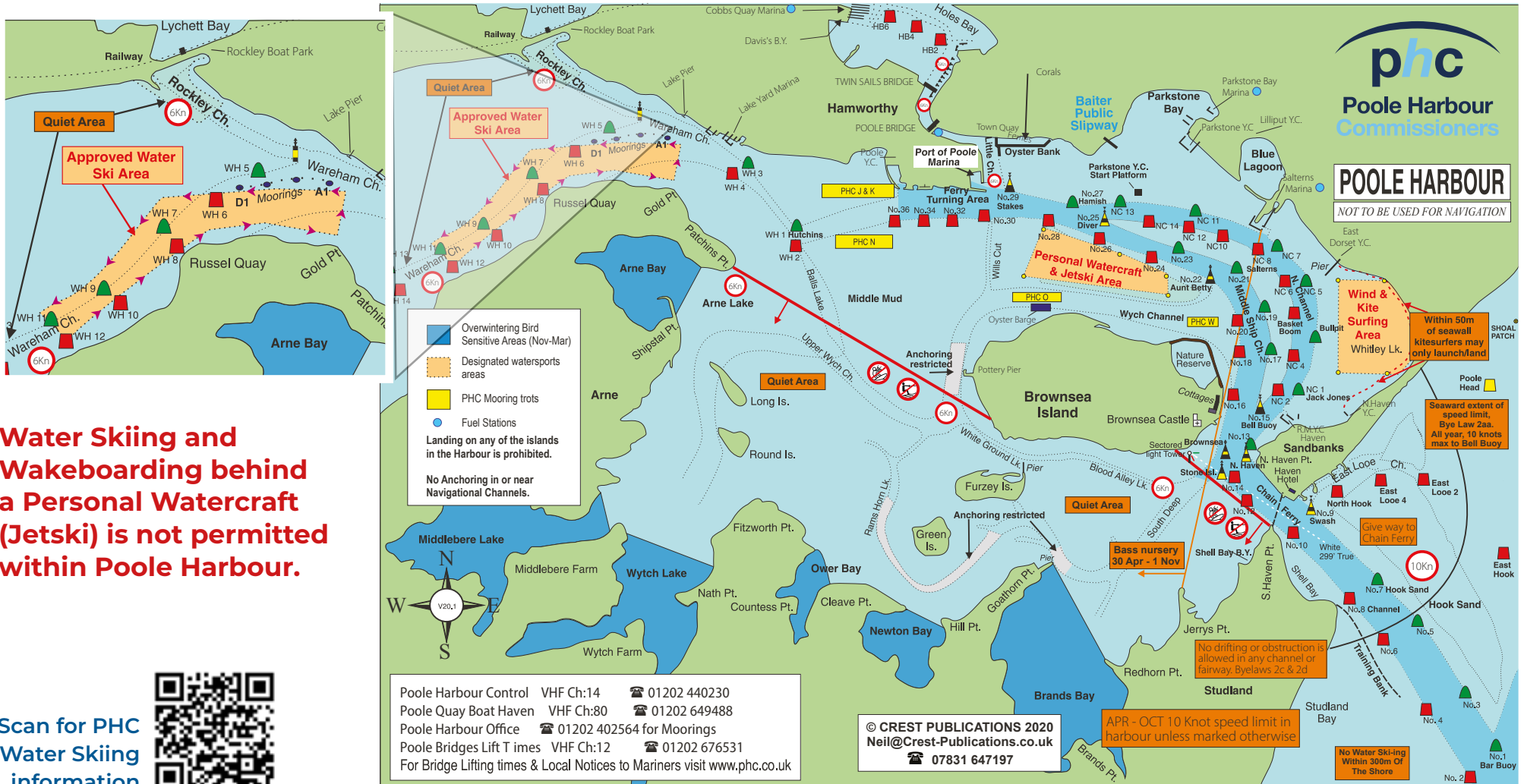

Water Skiing and Wake Boarding in Poole Harbour

Water Skiing and Wake Boarding may only take place in the designated area to the North of the Arne Peninsular, within the area marked by yellow buoys.

Only Vessels engaged in these activities, with a valid Permit, insurance and Harbour Dues can exceed the speed limit in the approved Water Ski area, when safe to do so.

Be aware of other Harbour users transiting the Wareham Channel.
