

Dredging Operations MDL Cobbs Quay Marina

Mariners are advised that dredging operations at Cobbs Quay Marina in Holes Bay will commence on or about the 9th November 2020 for approximately four weeks.

The work will be carried out by the backhoe dredger “Stour” or “Doreen Dorward”, with the spoil being disposed of at the ‘in harbour’ spoil ground East of Brownsea Island or the spoil ground approximately 3NM East of Swanage, by the hopper barges “Hurst”, “Nab” and “Needles”.

All vessels will be exhibiting the required lights and/or shapes as per the COLREGS.

Mariners are advised to navigate with extreme caution when the Split Barges are transiting Holes Bay, between the bridges and Little Channel, and are requested to keep clear of the “Stour” and “Doreen Dorward”.

Dates and timings are weather dependent.

This notice will self-cancel on completion of the dredging operation.

Mariners are reminded that radar, telephone and VHF Channels are recorded.
