As Statutory Harbour Authority, PHC is subject to what is known as "Open Port Duty". This means that the Harbour must be open to anyone, "for the shipping and unshipping of goods and the embarking and landing of passengers", on payment of the rates and other conditions set by the board. Therefore, Poole Harbour and the Port of Poole continues to remain open at this time and commercial shipping will continue to operate as usual.

Mariners are reminded that Radar, AIS, CCTV, Telephone and VHF Channels are recorded.

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Watersport Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
