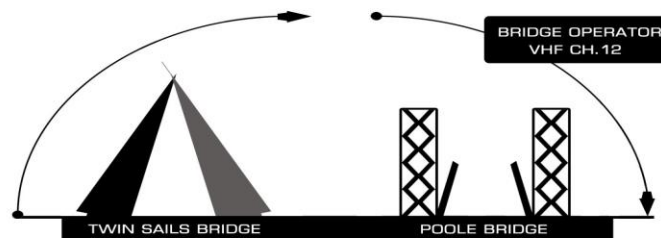


Poole Bridges Lifting Schedule

On Behalf Of BCP Council - Notice is given that this notice supersedes LNTM 03/2021

Mariners are advised that the Poole Bridges will no longer be lifting as per the maintenance schedule and with immediate effect will revert to the standard schedule.

BRIDGE LIFTING SEQUENCE
AFTER THE FIRST BRIDGE LIFT, THE SECOND BRIDGE WILL OPEN ASAP.
THE FIRST BRIDGE WILL OPEN AGAIN IF REQUIRED FOR RETURNING VESSELS



OPENS AT HALF PAST THE HOUR AT WEEKENDS (05:30-23:30)

05:30-14:30 | TWIN SAILS BRIDGE OPENS FIRST
POOLE BRIDGE OPENS APPROX 15 MINS LATER

15:30-23:30 | POOLE BRIDGE OPENS FIRST
TWIN SAILS BRIDGE OPENS APPROX 15 MINS LATER

WEEKDAYS - AS ABOVE WITH THESE EXCEPTIONS
NO BRIDGE LIFTS AT THE FOLLOWING TIMES:
08:30, 13:30, 17:30, 20:30

NOTES:

1. Times may vary depending on levels of boat traffic and the tidal stream.
2. The lifting sequence may not always commence with the Twin Sails Bridge opening first (05:30-14:30) nor the Poole Bridge opening first (15:30-23:30).
3. For ease of navigation, mariners may use the holding berths on the western / Hamworthy side of the basin between lifts.

Mariners are reminded that Radar, AIS, CCTV, Telephone and VHF Channels are recorded 24/7

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Water Sport Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
