

Cable Laying Between Goathorn Point and Furzey Island

Mariners are advised that a cable laying operation will be taking place between Furzey island and Goathorn point, the cable is 650 metres long and will be carried out by two Rib's and one Zodiac. The work will start on the 15th of February, and complete approximately on the 18th of February, dates are subject to weather and therefore there is the potential for an extension of the works duration.

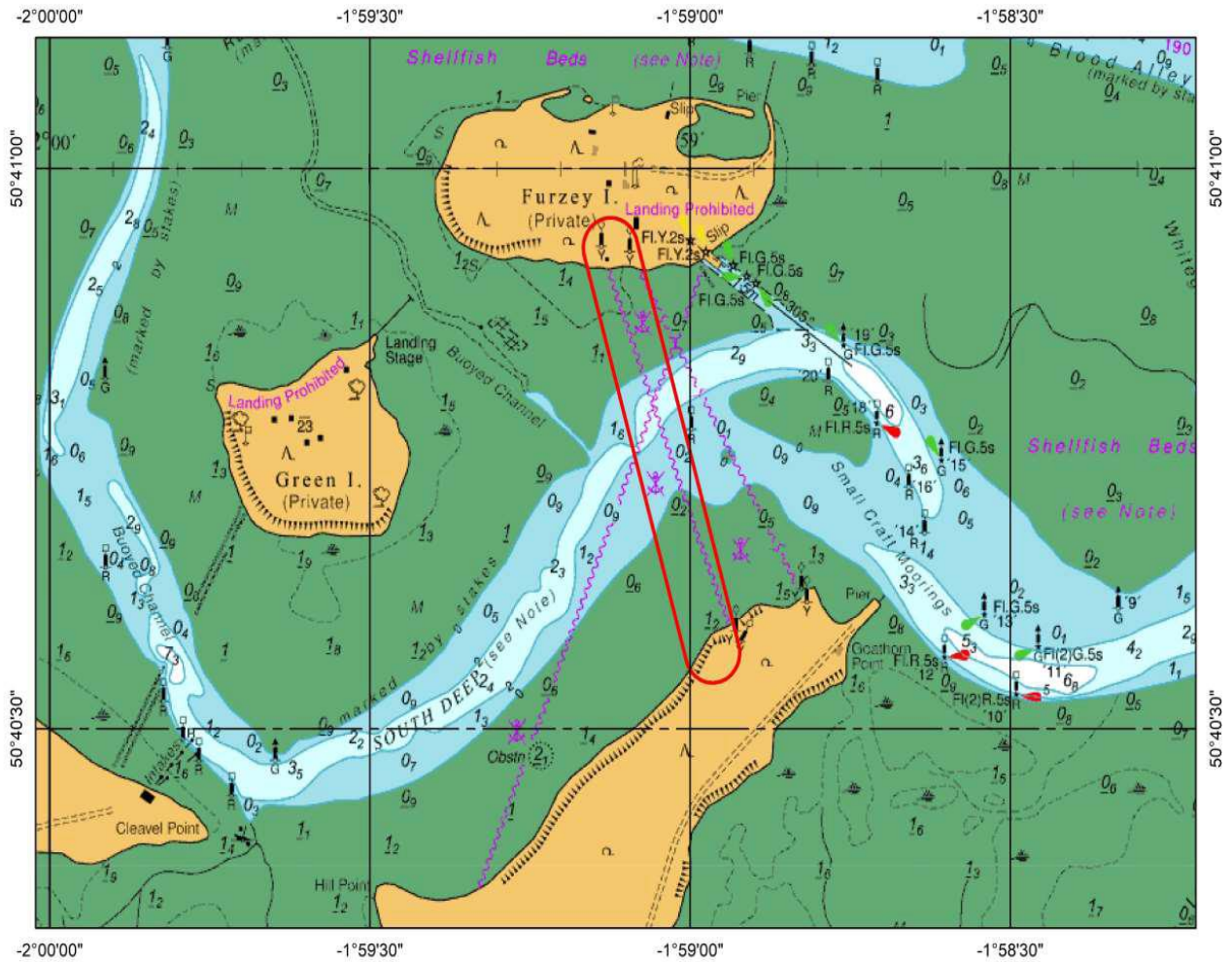
All vessels are requested to maintain a safe distance of 250 metres from the cable and support vessels. Access through South deep between Goathorn point and Furzey island will be restricted throughout the duration of the works.

Mariners are reminded that Radar, AIS, CCTV, Telephone and VHF Channels are recorded 24/7

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Water Sport Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
