

Brownsea Island Jetty Works

Mariners are advised that work will be taking place on the John Lewis jetty at the Eastern end of Brownsea Island from the 9th of May for approximately six weeks

Work will be carried out from the Doreen Dorward and flat top barge JML60 and also a small workboat, the vessels are expected to work Northeast of the Jetty.

Doreen Dorward can be contacted on CH14 for advice on passing.

All vessels should keep well clear and pass at a safe speed with minimum wash.

Mariners are reminded that Radar, AIS, CCTV, Telephone and VHF Channels are recorded 24/7

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Watersport Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
