

Rockley Viaduct Scour Protection Works

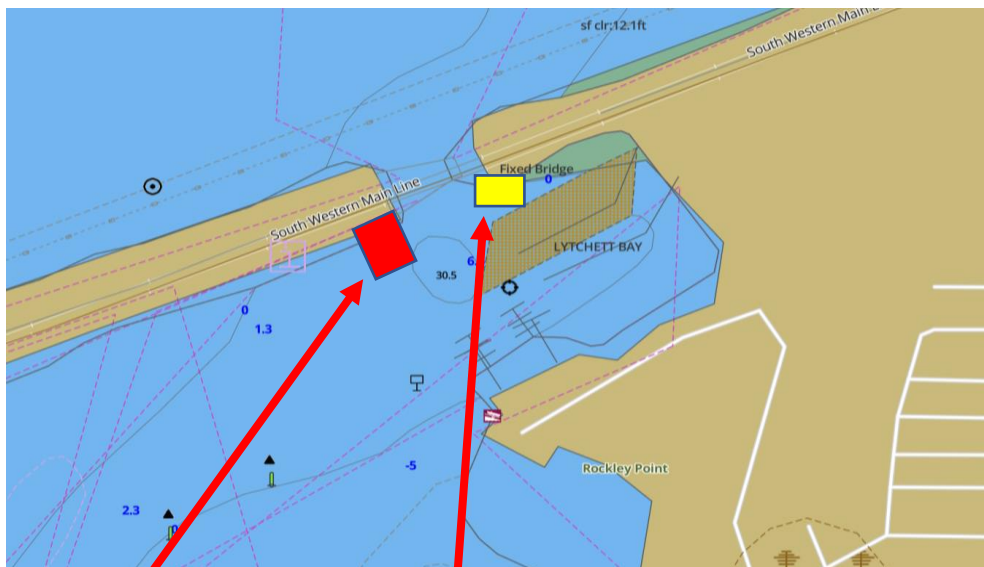
This Local Notice to Mariners is issued by Poole Harbour Commissioners on behalf of Network Rail

Mariners are advised that Scour protection works are being carried out in the channel under the Rockley Viaduct Bridge. Rock armour is being placed under the bridge to support the Eastern side pier, from a Pontoon sited immediately South of the bridge (Shown in Red). The rock armour is being transferred from another feeder pontoon (Shown in Yellow), being manoeuvred from Rockley Boat Park to the JML60 Pontoon. There will also be a Work Boat, and Safety Boat in attendance.

The Western half of the channel is also being re-profiled to reduce the amount of rock armour installed previously.

Work commences on Mon 3rd October 2022 and is planned to be completed by Friday 9th December 2022

All vessels should transit this area at slow speeds, with minimum wash whilst maintaining a proper lookout.
