

EXCLUSION ZONE POOLE HARBOUR FIREWORK DISPLAY

Mariners are advised that a fireworks display will take place in Poole Harbour on Saturday the 5th November. The display will be close to the Southern breakwater of Poole Quay Boat Haven and will commence at 20:00 for a duration of approximately 10 minutes.

A 100m exclusion zone will be in force around the firing position for approximately 20 minutes between 19:55 and 20:15. This is indicated by the cross on the attached chartlet and shown on the arial image.

A harbour patrol vessel with blue flashing lights will be close to the exclusion zone to ensure vessels keep a safe distance during the display.

Any vessel wishing to transit the area during this 20 minute period is requested to navigate with caution keeping a safe distance.

When departing the area, after the display, please observe the 6 knot speed limit in the Little Channel. Be mindful of your wash, display your navigation lights and be courteous to other harbour users.





Mariners are reminded that Radar, AIS, CCTV, Telephone and VHF Channels are recorded 24/7
