

### PERSONAL WATERCRAFT AREA – OBSTRUCTION (amended)

Mariners are advised of an obstruction in the jet ski area, North of Brownsea Island, approximate position 150 meters South Southwest of No. 28 Buoy

The obstruction is protruding approximately 0.5 meters from the seabed and has been marked with a temporary orange “Wreck” buoy. Mariners should navigate this area with extreme caution.

A further notice will be issued once the obstruction has been removed.

**Mariners are reminded that Radar, AIS, CCTV, Telephone and VHF Channels are recorded 24/7**

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Water Sport Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
