

Sandbanks Ferry Refit

Mariners are advised that the Sandbanks Ferry “Bramble Bush Bay” will shortly be coming off station for refit.

Subject to weather, the ferry will be disconnected from her chains and towed by Jenkins Marine workboats to a berth in the Port of Poole on Tuesday 5th November.

During the ferry’s absence, the chains within her usual overnight berthing location (on the South Haven / Studland side) will be marked with two orange buoys with yellow flashing lights. The outer buoy will be approximately 60 metres off the South Haven slipway.

This notice will self-cancel on the return of the ferry, which is expected to be Wednesday 20th November.

Mariners are reminded that Radar, AIS, CCTV, telephone and VHF channels are recorded 24-7.

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Water Sport Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
