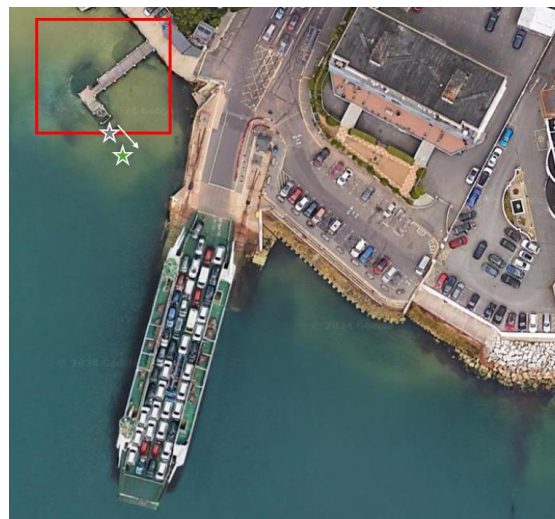
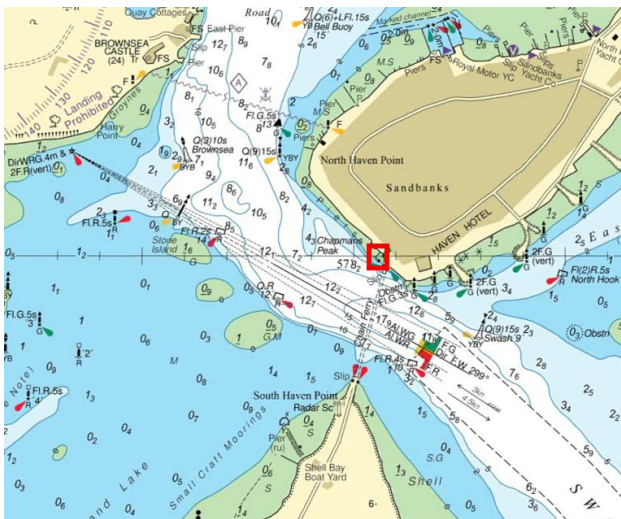


## Moving of Light following National Trust Sandbanks Jetty Removal

**Mariners are advised** that the jetty (located west of the Chain Ferry's northern ramp as indicated below) has been removed in readiness for construction of a replacement jetty later in 2025.

The charted green navigation light that marked the jetty has been relocated to a single remaining steel pile which is located 4 metres southeast of the light's charted position.

This steel pile will be removed during the future jetty's construction and the light will be moved again to a permanent position on the new jetty. LNTM 02 of 2025 is hereby cancelled. A further LNTM will be published ahead of construction starting and a chart correction will be arranged via the UKHO when construction completes.



**Mariners are reminded that Radar, AIS, CCTV, telephone and VHF channels are recorded 24-7.**
