

25th February Closure of Backwater Channel during Twin Sails Bridge Maintenance

This updated notice is issued on behalf of BCP Council

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that all bridge lifts will be cancelled on **25th** February whilst Twin Sails Bridge undergoes critical maintenance. It will remain in the lowered position throughout the day and will stay open to road traffic. The date has been changed from the previous day in order to accommodate planned commercial movements.

Low air draft vessels will be able to passage under the Twin Sails Bridge, proceeding with caution and contacting Bridge Control VHF 12.

This notice replaces LNTM 08 of 2025 (which is hereby cancelled). This notice is self-cancelling at 23.59 on 25th Feb 2025. LNTM 24 of 2024 (Bridge Lifts Timetable) will be suspended for the duration of 25th Feb and come back into force from first lift on the 26th Feb.

Mariners are reminded that Radar, AIS, CCTV, Telephone and VHF Channels are recorded 24-7.

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Water Sport Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
