

### Military Parachuting 20<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> May

This Local Notice to Mariners is issued by Poole Harbour Commissioners on behalf of the Royal Marines.

**MARINERS ARE ADVISED** that military parachute training will take place daily from Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> May to Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2025. The impact point will be selected each day based on current weather conditions from the following two options which are located outside of Poole Harbour Limits, to the east of the Swash Channel.

**Point A:** 50°39.742'N 001°52.624'W  
(1.65NM from Bar Buoy on a heading of 74°T)

**Point B:** 50°40.500'N 001°54.410'W  
(0.53NM from East Hook buoy a heading of 100°T)

Each has a voluntary exclusion zone of 1000 yard (0.5 NM) radius where mariners are advised to keep clear during training periods. For the safety of both mariners and parachutists, safety boats will be operating in the exclusion zone of the impact point selected to provide advice and information.

**Mariners are reminded that Radar, CCTV, telephone and VHF Channels are recorded 24-7.**

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Water sport Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft. This notice will self-cancel at 23:59 on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> of May 2025.
