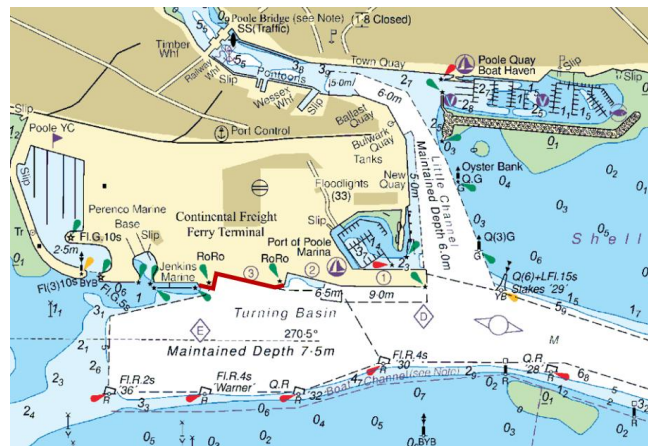


Diving Operations at RoRo3

Mariners are advised that daily underwater quay maintenance will be resuming from Monday 16th March at berth RoRo3, the berth frequently used by the BARFLUER and COMMODORE CLIPPER.

The dive team, “Apex Divers”, are displaying Flag Alpha on the quayside and, when weather allows, are also further safeguarding their operations using a small unmanned tender flying Flag Alpha anchored off their works location

This programme of underwater inspections and maintenance has been underway across PHC’s quaysides since December 2024. This final phase involves the install of anodes to extend the lifespan of the quay. This notice will self-cancel on completion of the works with target of beginning of May 2026.



Mariners should, as usual, monitor VHF Channel 14 when underway in the harbour or on its approaches. Poole VTS continue to issue hourly broadcasts advising on the exact location of current diving. Mariners must give the diving location as wide a berth as is safe to do so and must pass at minimum speed for safe steerage, in order to minimise their wash which poses a real risk of injury to divers engaged in underwater welding and other tasks.

Mariners are reminded that Radar, AIS, CCTV, telephone and VHF channels are recorded 24-7.

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Water Sport Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
